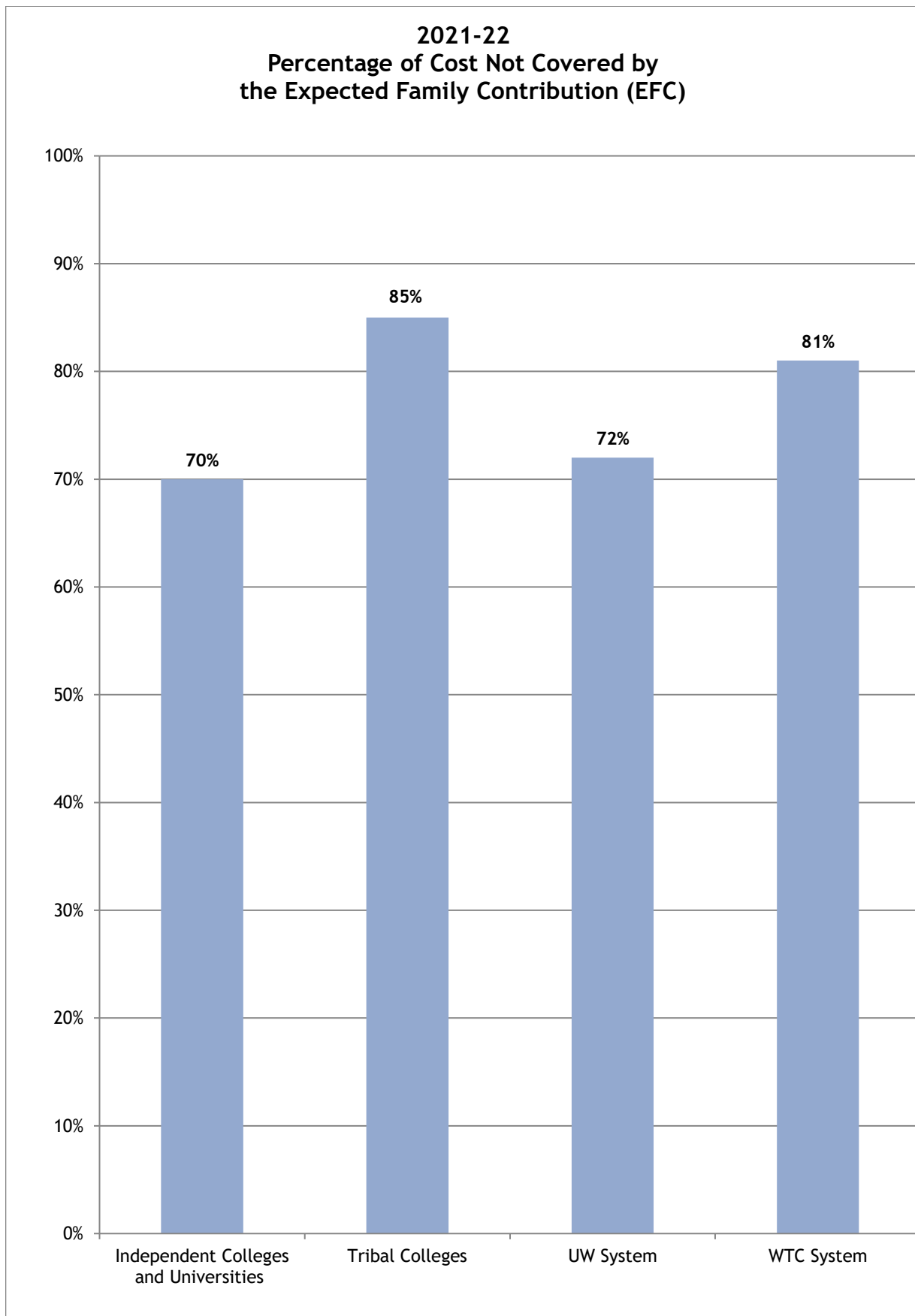

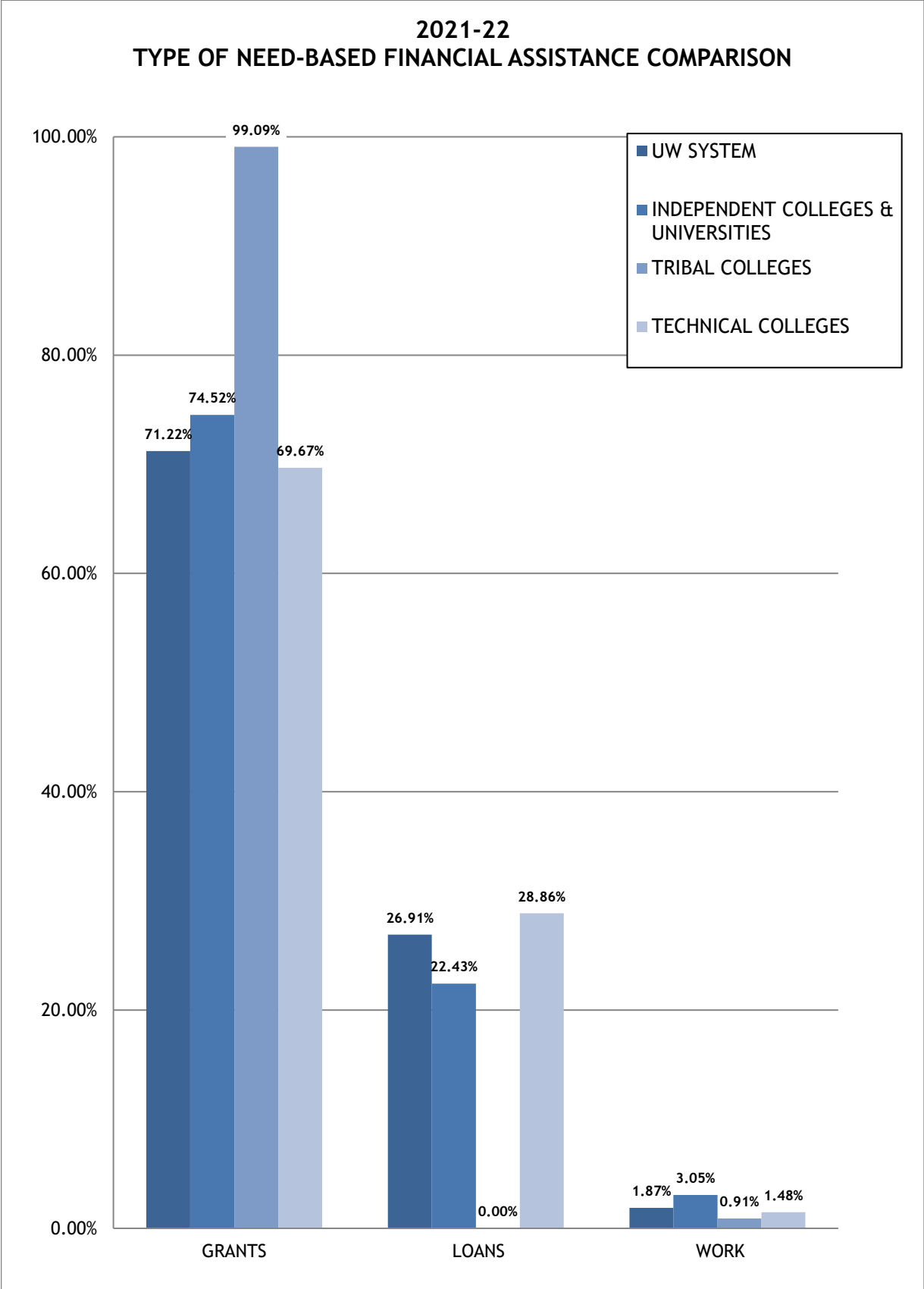




2021-22 Number of Wisconsin Residents who Applied for and Received Need-Based Aid

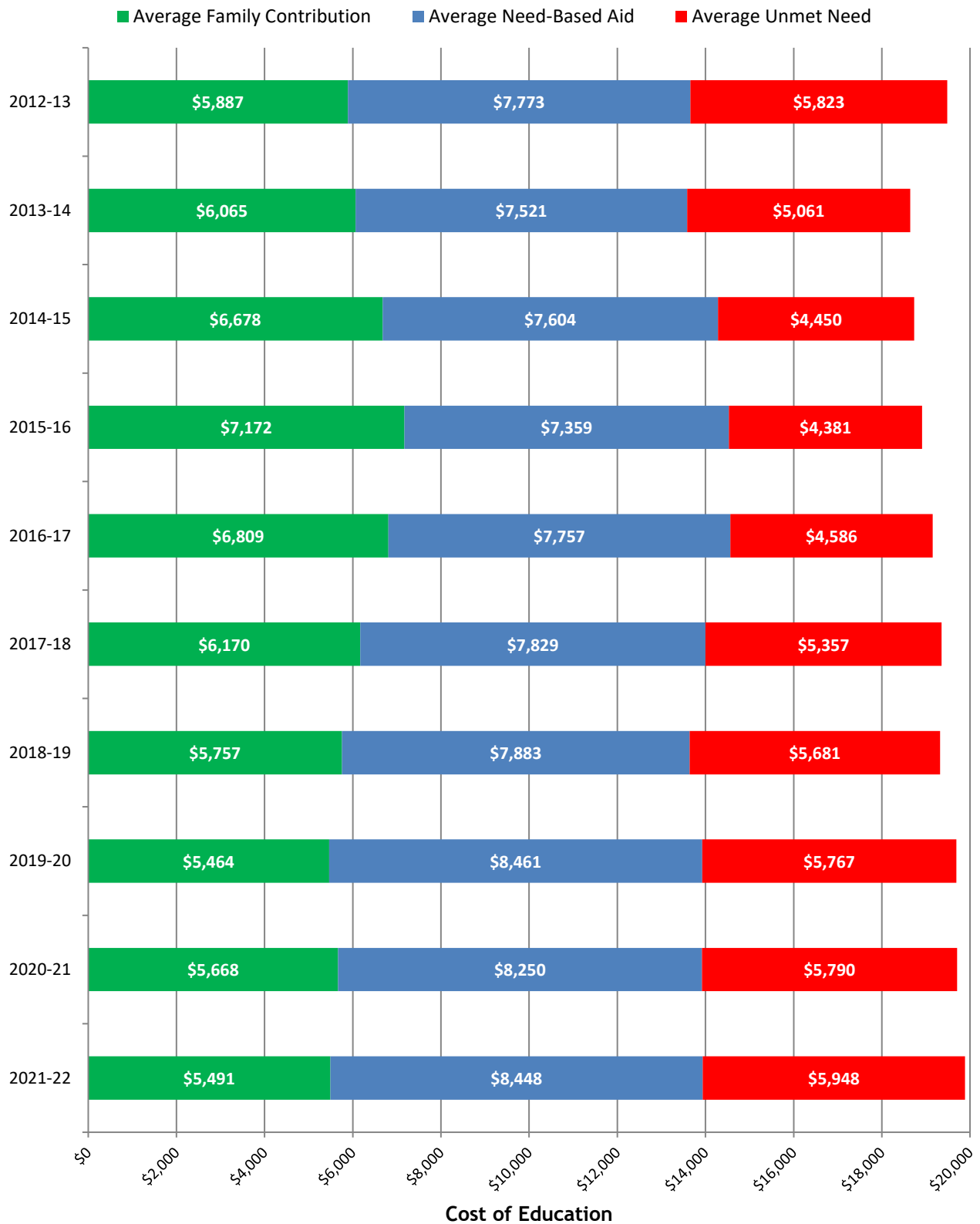

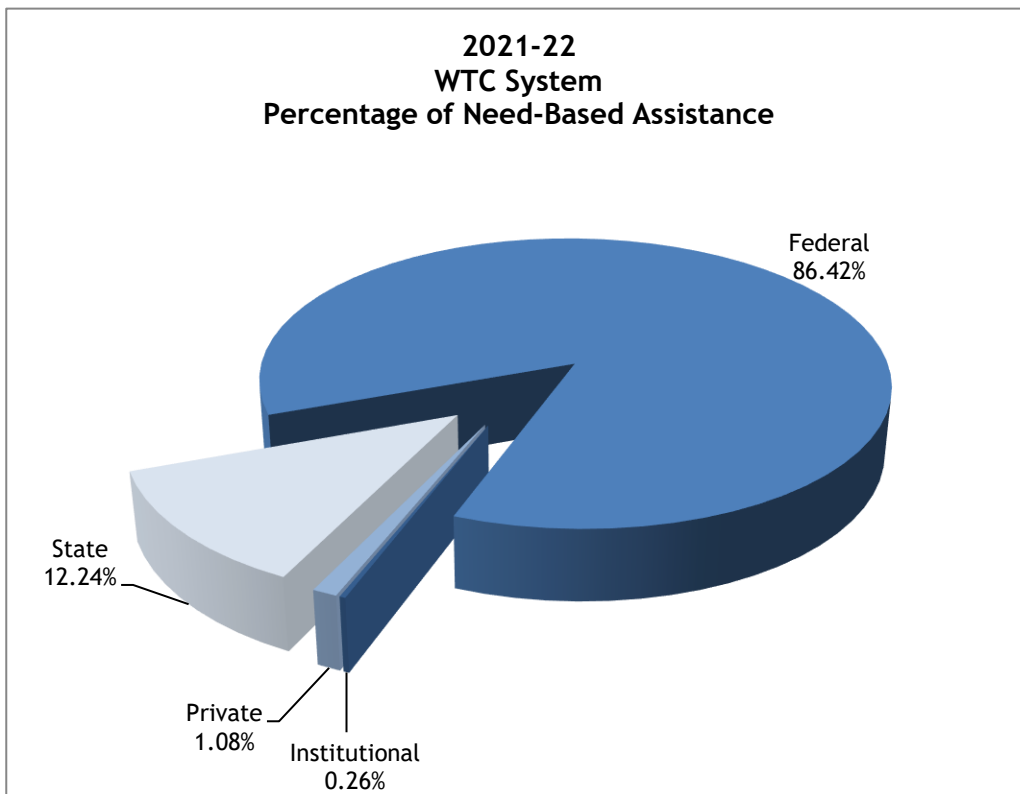

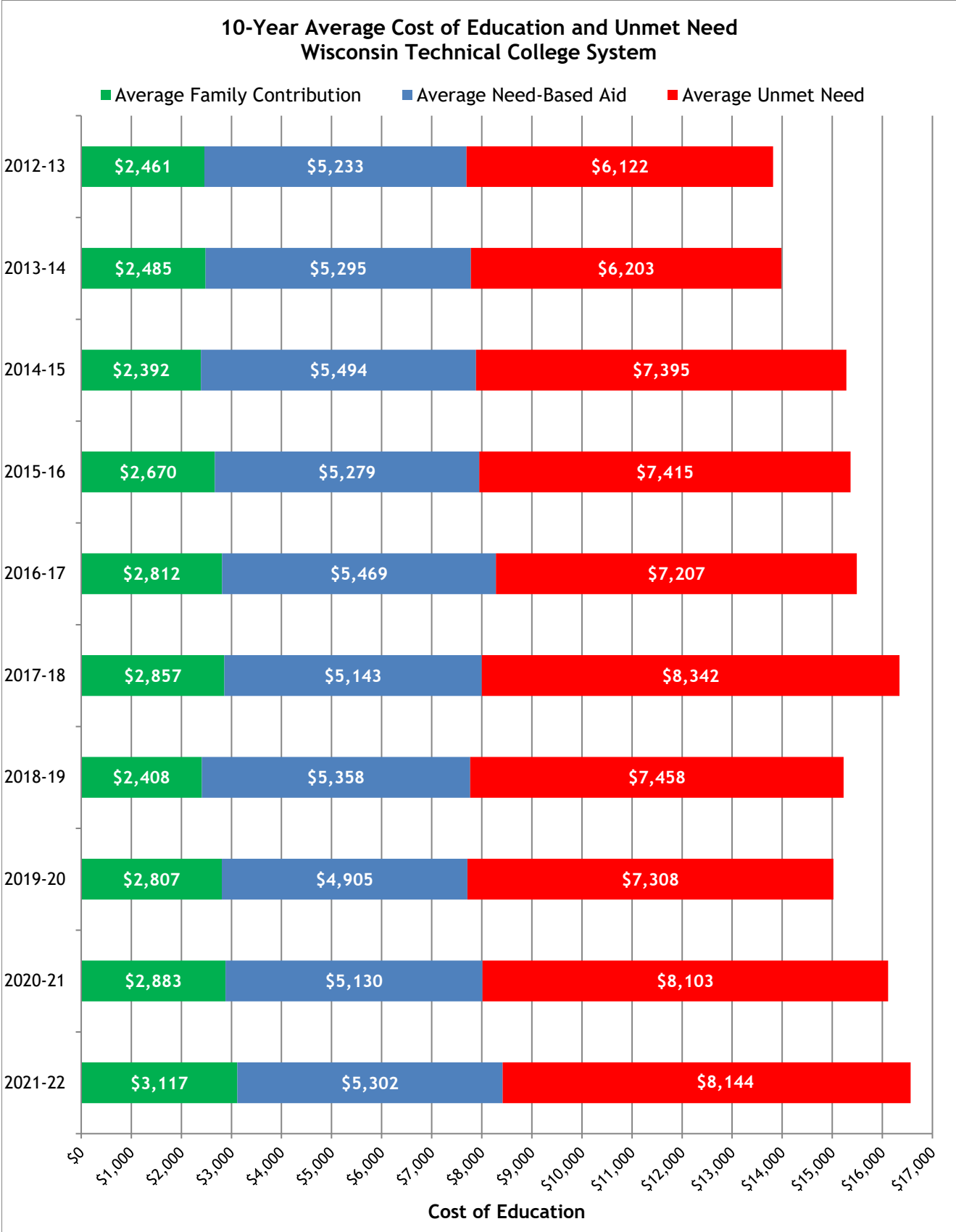
